STAGING AT 8:00 A.M. | OPECHEE PARK

PROCESSION ROUTE

- Leave Opechee Park heading south on North Main Street.
- Turn right on Church Street, then left on Pleasant Street.
- Loop around Pleasant Street to Main Street, passing in front of the Laconia Antique Center.
- Turn right on Church Street, then left on Messer Street.
- Head north on Union Avenue (U.S. Route 3).
- Turn left on Lake Street by Shaw's.
- Continue north on Weirs Boulevard (U.S. Route 3).
- Turn right on Lakeside Avenue at the Weirs Beach sign.
- Continue north on Scenic Road and Watson Road.
- Turn left on Endicott Street heading south, then bear right at the first exit of the roundabout onto Weirs Boulevard.
- Turn right on Union Avenue (U.S. Route 3).
- Continue south on U.S. Route 3, passing Laconia High School.
- Continue south and bear left onto Academy Street by the courthouses, entering Union Cemetery.

12:00 P.M. - CELEBRATION OF LIFE: NazBar Beach Bar, all day/night.

ACCESS TO THE NASWA RESORT: Use White Oaks Road or Rollercoaster Road **ONLY** due to construction at Langley Cove/Christmas Island Bridge.

PARKING & SHUTTLE: Two level parking lot at NASWA motorcycles only. Handicap Parking available. Golf cart shuttle from lot to NazBar provided. Overflow motorcycle and car parking is available throughout Weirs Beach, including the Weirs Beach Drive-In, Lucerne Avenue Parking Lot, and Lakeside Avenue. Shuttle service is available until 4:00 p.m.

7:00 P.M. - FILMS IN CHARLIE'S HONOR. Hosted by the Weirs Beach Drive-In: Arrive at the Weirs Beach Drive-In by 7:00 p.m.; doors close at 7:30 p.m. Two tribute films will be shown.

10:00 P.M. - FIREWORKS: Fireworks in the Weirs will end our celebration.
